The children diligently prepare for the topic, and during the competition, questions related to the topic are asked. Those who answer the questions most accurately and comprehensively qualify for prizes. This activity fosters healthy competition among the students.



Technology Club

In this club, children are introduced to the world of computers. They learn about the fundamental components of computers and how to utilize them effectively.



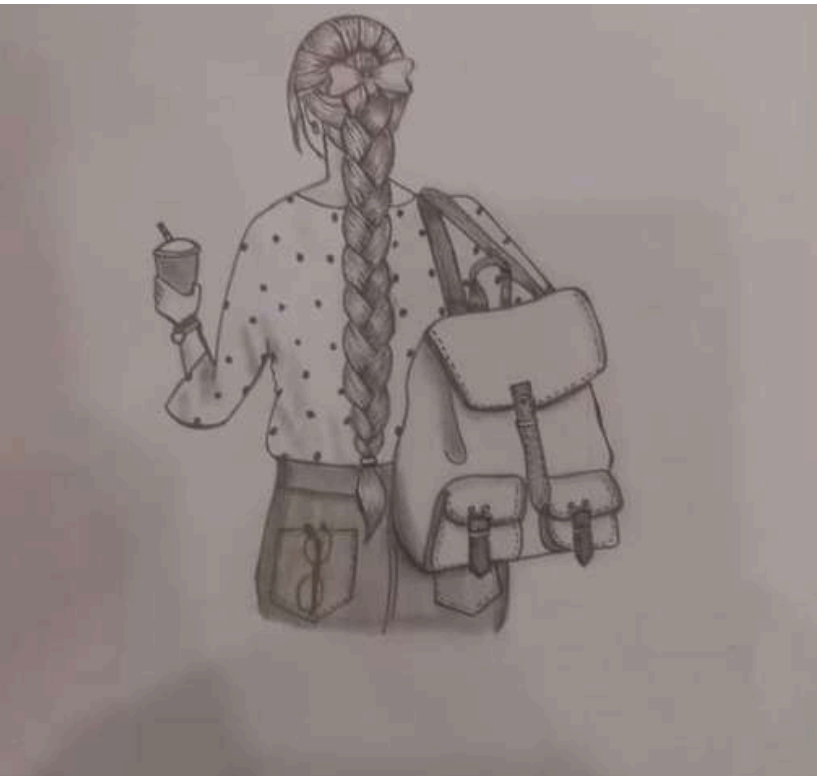


Urdu Writing Club

Computer Course Offered by CCRC

what's a leap year?

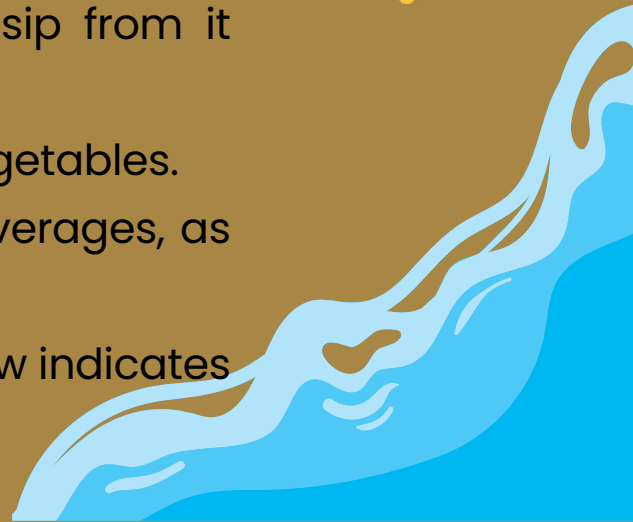

Staying hydrated is essential for maintaining overall health and well-being. Here are a few tips to help you stay hydrated:

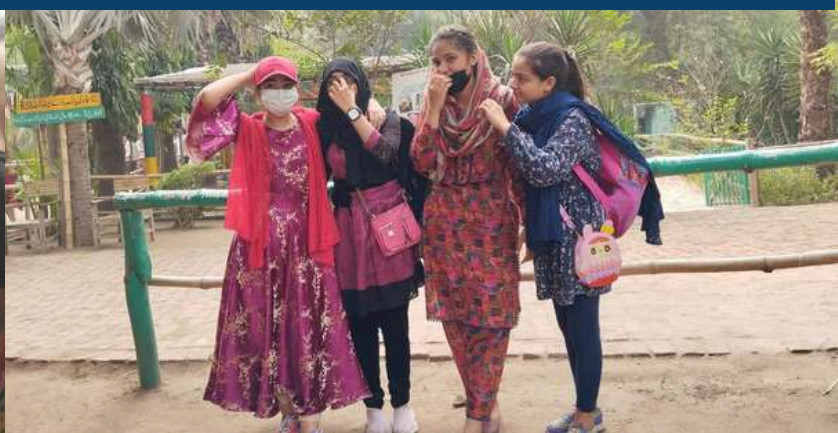
- Drink water regularly throughout the day, even if you don't feel thirsty.
